

# FA Education Licensing Requirements 2017/2018

## Affiliate Tutor Referee Education

### FA Referees Course



#### Tutor purpose:

Ensure effective delivery of FA Education courses, specifically the FE Referees Course and In Service Training. Work closely with the County FA and Referee Tutor Developer in contributing to a consistent learner experience across the coaching pathway and associated courses within the county. Deliver good quality learning sessions that deliver content in a dynamic and inspiring manner.

#### Key accountabilities as a licensed tutor:

- Deliver FA Education in the manner intended and in line with the FA Affiliate Tutor Principles of Practice.
- Demonstrate high expectations of yourself and learners ensuring a positive learning experience for all.
- Maintain correct and timely records of learner attendance and achievement.
- Provide individualised support for learners, as designed by the course, to maximise learner potential and drive progression.
- Commit to continual professional development, supporting quality processes and maintaining an individual Tutor Action Plan.
- Maintain mandatory training requirements, ensuring they are in date at all times.

#### Essential requirements of a licensed tutor:

- Knowledge and understanding of current refereeing development and practices.
- Experience of delivery training to adults and young people.

#### Desirable requirements of a licensed tutor:

- Evidence of actively working with referees within the last 12 months.
- Experience of responding to the developmental needs of individual referees.

#### Tutor licence specifics:

<b>Minimum delivery requirements</b>	Must commit to a minimum of 2 courses per season.
<b>Fees</b>	Recommended £470 inclusive of expenses.
<b>Delivery Pattern</b>	FA Referees Course is 2.5 days of delivery, usually with days spaced apart.
<b>Tutor Ratio</b>	FA Referees Course 1:12
<b>Course content</b>	Face to face delivery.
<b>Professional development</b>	On- going bespoke development activity based on feedback from quality development processes and your Tutor Action Plan.
<b>Mandatory training</b>	In date FA CRC, Safeguarding Children and Level 1 Introduction to First Aid in Football (or in date Emergency Aid).
<b>Kit</b>	Please wear current Referee Tutor kit. New kit will be provided to you for the 18/19 season.
