RD02/21 Minutes

RD02/21.01 – Minutes of the Referee Committee February 2020





RD05/21 - RA Report

G. Jolley gave an update on the situation the RA finds itself in. This year's membership figures are down due to two primary reasons;

- lack of renewal uptake compounded by the inability to purchase membership as part of the referee registration process.
- · Lack of new referees being made members due to limited courses

G. Jolley advised that he would work with S. Anderson to engage with the newsletter and would re-engage with social media networks to give a consistent outreach from the RA.

P.W. Hill advised that he believes nationally that RA figures are down on last season.

RD06/21.01 - Courses

S. Anderson advised that a course had been ran in October which had 18 individuals in attendance which was successful with many having refereed a fixture prior to lockdown.

Lander, M. Leach, Robert Windle and Richard Fullicks. Unfortunately, two were unsuccessful in M. Leach and R. Windle, but three were successful in S. Anderson, D. Lander and R. Fullicks.
- S. Anderson advised that there was a strong pool of tutors in neighbouring counties that we could reach out to should we need to.

The Cambs CORE group has been advised of those involved this year and allocated appropriate coaches. RD09/21.06 – Mentoring Updates


So far we have mentored 20 unique officials so far this season with a mixture of Saturday and Sunday youth football.



S.Anderson advised that it is not likely that we will be able to run courses until March 2021 but when we are able to do so, we have a process in place. At present we have a Expression of Interest form live for individuals to advise of their interest in courses. A selection process will be used, and more tailored courses will be running i.e. Adult Only, Youth Only, Female Only to help encourage a greater engagement from those areas.


Once we get into the 2021/22 player registration window, we will be able to use the data available of players that haven't re-registered and direct market to them details of referee courses to gather interest.
