Referee Female Pathway Promotion Scheme Criteria Level 4W - 3W



The 2019-2020 Cambridgeshire FA Referees' Female Pathway Promotion Scheme falls into two categories, Level 4W - Level 3W and Level 3W to Level 2W, both of which have their own criteria. Therefore it is crucial that you fully understand the requirements and commitment needed (see below) before completing the Application Form to join the scheme.

A deposit of £20 must be submitted with your application either paid by cheque or credit/debit card. This will be refunded to those candidates that complete the stipulated criteria regardless to whether or not they are successful in gaining promotion at the end of the season.

Level 4W to 3W will see referees promoted from County League Referee to Women's National League Referee.

Level 4W to 3W Candidates:

- 1) Must officiate on 11-a-side Adult (open age) football and Referee a minimum of 20 games during the Promotion Period, which is from 1 June 2020 to 30 April 2021. 70% of these fixtures (14 games), must be in women's adult football). The other 30% can be completed in either Youth football or male football.
- 2) Must complete a minimum of 3 games as an Assistant Referee, ideally on the Women's National League.
- 3) Receive a minimum of 3 observations on women's games attaining 3 standard expected or above.
- 4) Must undertake and pass the required FA Laws of the Game examination.
- 5) Must attend at least one Promotion In-Service Training webinar.
- 6) Be proficient in completing misconduct reports using The FA's Whole Game System within the stipulated time-frame.
- 7) Complete the online Referee Re-Registration process by 1st September 2020.
