Referee Promotion Scheme Criteria Level 5 - 4



The 2019-2020 Cambridgeshire FA Referees' Promotion Scheme falls into three categories, Level 7 to 6, Level 6 to 5, and Level 5 to 4, all of which have their own criteria. Therefore it is crucial that you fully understand the requirements and commitment needed (see below) before completing the Application Form to join the scheme.

A deposit of £20 must be submitted with your application either paid by cheque or credit/debit card. This will be refunded to those candidates that complete the stipulated criteria regardless to whether or not they are successful in gaining promotion at the end of the season.

Level 6 to 5 Candidates:

- 1) Must officiate on 11-a-side Adult (open age) football and Referee a minimum of 20 games during the Promotion Period, which is from 1 June 2020 to 30 April 2021.
- 2) Undertake a minimum of 8 appointments as an Assistant Referee on a senior league in the promotion period.
- 3) Must attend at least one Promotion In-Service Training webinar.
- 4) Must undertake and pass the required FA Laws of the Game Examination.
- 5) Will receive a minimum of 3 observations, arranged by the County FA
- 6) Must officiate on league(s) that can supply referee marks. If not officiating on a Cambridgeshire league, you must submit your appointments to ensure observers are appointed.
- 7) Be proficient in completing misconduct report using The FA Whole Game system.
- 8) Complete the online re-registration process by 1 September 2020.
