Referee Promotion Scheme Criteria Level 7 - 6

The 2019-2020 Cambridgeshire FA Referees' Promotion Scheme falls into three categories, Level 7 to 6, Level 6 to 5, and Level 5 to 4, all of which have their own criteria. Therefore it is crucial that you fully understand the requirements and commitment needed (see below) before completing the Application Form to join the scheme.

A deposit of £20 must be submitted with your application either paid by cheque or credit/debit card. This will be refunded to those candidates that complete the stipulated criteria regardless to whether or not they are successful in gaining promotion at the end of the season.

LEVEL 7 TO 6 CANDIDATES:

- 1) Must have refereed a minimum of 20 games in one registration period prior to application.
- 2) Must be regularly officiating 11-a-side Adult (open-age) football at the time of application.
- 3) Will be required to referee a minimum of 20 competition matches during the Promotion Period which is from 1 June 2020 to 30 April 2020 of which a minimum of 14 must be in Adult (open age) football.
- 4) Must complete a minimum of 5 games as an Assistant Referee on a Supply League Pool or County Cup matches.
- 5) Must attend at least one Promotion In-Service Training webinar.
- 6) Must attend the mid-season Evaluation & Review webinar.
- 7) Must undertake and pass the required FA Laws of the Game examination.
- 8) Must complete and submit on a monthly basis a match record sheet listing games between the qualifying dates
- 9) Will receive a minimum of 2 match assessments (we arrange)
- 10) Must officiate on a league(s) that can supply marks from the member clubs.
- 11) Be proficient in completing misconduct reports using The FA Whole Game system and submitting within the stipulated time-frame.
- 12) Complete the on-line re-registration process by 1 September 2020.
