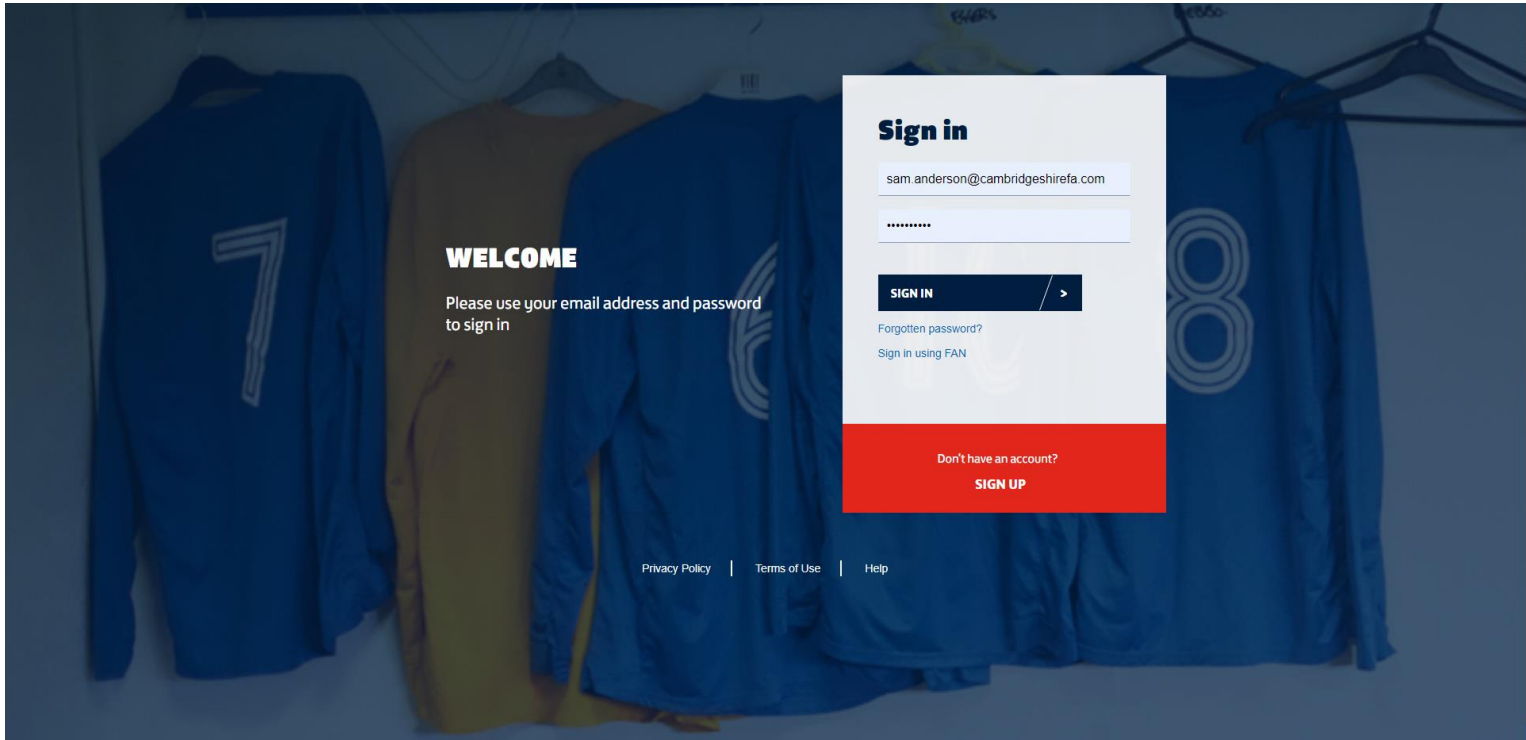


Giving Consent to a 14 or 15 year old referee for Registration

New for the 2021/2022 season is the requirement for Parents/Carers to give consent to their Son/Daughter to register for the new season, this is a simple process and can be done by following the instructions below.

- 1) Visit <http://myaccount.thefa.com> and login with your email address and password.

- 3) Once you can see your Son/Daughter's name, firstly check the Parent/Carer links are correct underneath their details. If there are any incorrect, please urgently email referees@cambridgeshirefa.com and highlight it as URGENT for this to be resolved.
- 4) Once checked, scroll down until you see the Referee Section. You should see a variation of the below (depending on years registered).
