# Introduction



COVID-19 has impacted on The FA and Cornwall FA's ability to offer face to face education. Whilst long term plans are being made to offer alternative, sustainable delivery models it is necessary to make temporary changes for the 2020/2021 season. The document highlights the interim qualification requirements which will be updated if/when needed and will be superseded when new courses are launched.

Existing coaches, managers and assistants in youth teams	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li><b>Level 1 in Coaching Football</b></li><li><b>If not yet completed Level 1 in Coaching Football</b> - complete FA Playmaker (Includes The FA "Safeguarding for All", "Sudden Cardiac Arrest" and "Concussion") - <a href="#">take the course</a> or The FA Safeguarding for All - <a href="#">take the course</a> if not completed the safeguarding part of the L1 and/or Sudden Cardiac Arrest - <a href="#">take the course</a> and Concussion - <a href="#">take the course</a> if not completed the first aid workshop of the L1 course</li><li><b>In-date FA DBS</b></li><li><b>In-date Emergency Aid</b> - (Coaches whose IFAiF has expired/will expire between the 1 February 2020 and 31 July 2021 will have an extension applied on their FAN records through until 31 July 2021. Continuing referees planning to referee in youth football	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Referee Qualification</li><li>2. In-date FA DBS - (if over 16 years of age)</li><li>3. In-date Safeguarding Children Certificate - (if have attended a face to face Safeguarding Children Workshop)- <a href="#">recertify here</a>. If not, must complete Safeguarding for All certificate - <a href="#">take the course</a></li><li>4. Parent FAN link - (if under 18 years of age)</li></ol>
