Introduction



COVID-19 has impacted on The FA and Cornwall FA's ability to offer face to face education. Whilst long term plans are being made to offer alternative, sustainable delivery models it is necessary to make temporary changes for the 2020/2021 season. The document highlights the interim qualification requirements which will be updated if/when needed and will be superseded when new courses are launched.
