- Mini (Soccer) Football rules still apply, plus additional rules noted below.
- Completed player sheets to be handed in at registration, between 8:45am-9.30am. All players must have been eligible to play for the 2020/21 season, within their age group.
- No players are allowed to participate within more than one team in the same age group.
- Age groups will play 5 a side (U7s & U8s and Adults), 6 a side (U9s-U15s) and we recommend up to 3 subs as a maximum of 10 trophies will be supplied for winning and runner up teams. If any club chooses to bring more than 10 players only 10 trophies will be supplied.
- Each game will commence by the two competing teams meeting the referee at a designated yellow corner flag. Players will complete the respect handshake in the middle of the field before the game commences.
- Each game will be 6 minutes each way, with a change of ends at half time.
- Rolling substitutions will be accepted, but only with the referee's authorisation. The ball must not be in play when changes are made.
- No offside rules apply.
- Goalkeepers are asked to release the ball by throw only, except on goal & free kicks. During a goal kick the opposition team must be back on the half way line.
- Any ball played back to the goalkeeper by fellow team mate must not be handled. Indirect free kick inside the area will be given.
- U7s will play a friendly league; NO scores recorded all players to receive a certificate. All other age groups will be as follows.... WIN = 3 Points, DRAW = 1 Point, LOSE = 0 Points. If two teams accumulate same points with all games played, the following decisions will apply. • 1 – Goal Difference • 2 – Highest Number of Goals Scored • 3 – Final result between teams in group stage • If all else fails – Sudden Death Penalty Shoot Out
- The scores and live tables will be available through a monitor in the fixture gazebo and the two TVs in the clubhouse, any discrepancy must be reported immediately and will not be accepted after the group stages. Once the semi finals have begun no changes can be made.
- Top four teams in the league will go straight into Semi's & then the Final. If a Game is tied at full time – 2mins extra time to be played each way. If still no deciding goal has been scored, penalties will commence.

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- Referee's have the FINAL decision on the field of play. Respect of the referee's decision must be upheld by all participants, i.e. Players, Coaches/ Managers & spectators. If for any reason there is a reported incident of abuse, then official warnings to the individual and club will be issued. If the problem persists then you may be asked to leave the tournament.
- In the unfortunate event of a RED card being produced the offending player will miss the next game in the fixture list.
- 2 x YELLOW cards will result in missing next fixture.
- Player's equipment must adhere to the 'Laws of Association Football'. All players must wear shin pads for protection. Please take into account ground conditions, so trainers or boots may be worn depending on playing surface condition.
