This post is a fixed term contract (part-time) 1-2 hours per week plus fixtures over 30 weeks for 1 year with a view to it being extended subject to relevant FA funding and successful reapplication.

The successful applicant will be responsible for:

- The welfare of players within their designated age group(s)
- Providing high quality coaching and support
- Implementing a training programme in line with ETC/ADC guidelines
- · Preparing and delivering/supporting two player assessments during the programme
- Maintaining and controlling equipment and first aid kit for age group(s)
- Time keeping to arrive and set up prior to delivering session
