

<u>The FA Licensed Coaches Club</u> is free to join and provides session plans, videos, news and the latest ideas for coaches. To join you need to be a minimum Level 1 Coach, and hold current FA Criminal Record Check (CRC), Emergency First Aid and Safeguarding Children Certificates.

The benefits of being a licensed coach include a website with printable session plans & coaching videos, free tickets for all England Teams (ballot entry), a photo ID card and free download of The Boot Room: The FA's coaching magazine.

Using the FA Licensed Coaches Club Website:

FAN Number

Your FAN number is your own unique coaching record with The FA, and is automatically updated with all coaching qualifications and CRC checks you complete.

See <u>here</u> if you have forgotten your FAN or password.



You need your FAN number to use The FA Licensed Coaches Club, the Whole Game System (The FA's website for running clubs), and to enrol onto courses.

If you have previously done an FA course, played or volunteered within football, you will have a FAN number. Do not create a 2nd FAN number for yourself under any circumstance! If you are unsure contact Devon County FA.

Coach Mentoring

Devon has a team of 7 Coach Mentors (funded by The FA) working with Level 1 and 2 coaches across the County, with a view of helping them to improve.

Mentors are generally assigned to Charter Standard Clubs (around 20 are selected each season); however it is possible for a small number of individual coaches to be mentored—contact your nearest mentor below, or attend a free coaching CPD event.



- Mentoring can be 1-1 or in a group
- Mentoring is free
- Mentors do not replace you as a coach, but can give you feedback & ideas
- Encourage your club to apply!
