Coach Development Workshops | **Full Package:**

Length / Format of workshop: 2 hours - 1 hour theory & 1 hour practical.

Date / Day / Time: As requested by the club (availability dependent).

Venue: All workshops are delivered at the clubs training venue. A classroom and pitch are required for this package.

How many workshops can a club access during the 2024-2025 season? Clubs can access up to a maximum of 4 workshops during the season, delivered as and when required.

Cost: £70.00 per workshop. Clubs to pay for the workshop/s in advance.

Practical Demonstrations: Can be delivered to the coaches, or a team from within the club.

Number of Attendees / Coaches: A minimum of 10 coaches must be registered for the event to take place. Unlimited coaches can attend.

Coach Developers: All workshops will be delivered by our team of Durham CFA Coach Developers, all of whom have a wealth of experience in supporting coaches through the delivery of Coach Education / Development courses.

CPD Accreditation: Any coach who attends a Coach Development event will receive CPD accreditation from England Learning, which will be logged next to their FAN and is a strong demonstration of good practice.

Presentations / Session Plans: All coaches will receive copies of the presentations and / or session plans.

Length / Format of workshop: 1 hour - 1 hour practical.

Date / Day / Time: As requested by the club (availability dependent).

Venue: All workshops are delivered at the clubs training venue. Only a pitch is required for this package.

How many workshops can a club access during the 2024-2025 season? Clubs can access up to a maximum of 4 workshops during the season, delivered as and when required.

Cost: £40.00 per workshop. Clubs to pay for the workshop/s in advance.

Practical Demonstrations: Delivered to a team from the club at their usual training session.

Number of Attendees / Coaches: The coaches from the selected team must be present. Any other coaches from within the club are encouraged to attend, particularly those working with a similar age group.

Coach Developers: All workshops will be delivered by our team of Durham CFA Coach Developers, all of whom have a wealth of experience in supporting coaches through the delivery of Coach Education / Development courses.

CPD Accreditation: Any coach who attends a Coach Development event will receive CPD accreditation from England Learning, which will be logged next to their FAN and is a strong demonstration of good practice.
