MENTORING SUPPORT FOR ASPIRATIONAL COACHES.

WHAT IS MENTORING?

The role of a mentor typically involves supporting, encouraging & challenging coaches to manage their own learning within their own specific context, helping them maximise their potential, develop their skills and recognise their attributes; all tailored towards them becoming the coach and person they want to be. (England Learning.)

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF ACCESSING MENTORING SUPPORT?

- Develop knowledge, application and craft.
- Build confidence and competence.
- Become more aware of strengths and areas for development.
- Have access to a sounding board, where you'll continually be checked and challenged.
- Qualification specific support.
- Age-Appropriate support, specific to the male or female game.

WHAT SUPPORT IS ON OFFER?

- One to one, face to face support, on and off the pitch.
- Support with planning, delivery and reflection.
- Support at Training (observation and feedback; co-delivery; modelling best practice).
- Support on Match Days (observation and feedback; timely prompts).
- Verbal and/or written feedback, where appropriate.
- Reflective conversations to support and develop.
- Action Plans, where appropriate.
- Mentees would be expected to attend regular CPD events throughout the season.
- Mentees might be brought together periodically with other mentees to form small group workshops.

WHO CAN ACCESS THE MENTORING SUPPORT?

The Mentoring Support is open for all qualified coaches to apply for, from Level 1 | Introduction to Coaching to Level 3 | UEFA B, detailing their specific reasons for wanting to receive support. All applications will be reviewed by The Coach Development Team. The application window remains live throughout the season.
