In-House Club / Coach Development Offer



General Information:

- Venue: All workshops are delivered at the clubs training venue.
- Date / Day / Time: As requested by the club (dependent upon Coach Developer availability).
- Length of workshop: 2 hours.
- Workshop format:
 - One hour theory and one hour practical, or;
 - Two hours of practical.
- How many workshops can clubs access during the 23-24 season? Clubs can access 3-4 workshops. These can be delivered how clubs require, i.e. once a week for 3-4 weeks, one every 2-3 months, etc.
- Cost: £60.00 per workshop. Clubs to pay for their 3-4 workshops in advance.
- Practical Demonstrations: Can be delivered to the coaches in attendance, or a team/s from within the club. The practical can be focussed around the Foundation Phase (5-11yrs) or Youth Development Phase (12-16yrs).
- Number of Attendees / Coaches: A minimum of 10 coaches must be registered for the event to take place. Unlimited coaches can attend.
- Coach Developers: All workshops will be delivered by our team of Durham CFA Coach Developers, all of whom have a wealth of experience in supporting coaches through the delivery of Coach Education / Development courses.
- CPD Accreditation: Any coach who attends a Coach Development event will receive CPD accreditation from England Learning, which will be logged
 next to their FAN and is a strong demonstration of good practice.
- Presentations / Session Plans: All coaches will receive copies of the presentations and / or session plans.
