## **Player Development Centre Privacy Notice:**

**Why we need your personal data:** This is to register you for the above programme and to ensure you are eligible to play within this programme. This form will be destroyed once your data has been entered on to the Player Development administration system.

- **Who we share your personal data with:** Your data will be entered onto the Durham County F.A. Player Development System for administration purposes only.
- **How long we hold your personal data:** We keep your personal data for as long as you are registered with the programme for the 2018/2019 season.

### **Why we need your personal data**

We will only use personal data for any purpose for which it has been specifically provided.

The reason we need participants' and members' personal data is to be able to run the Player Development Centre and to administer the programme. Our lawful basis for processing this personal data is that we have a contractual obligation to anyone as a participant or member to provide the services they are registering for.

We have set out below, in a table format, a description of all the ways we plan to use personal data, and which of the legal bases we rely on to do so. We have also identified what our legitimate interests are where appropriate.

**Protection of your personal data:** We have put in place appropriate security measures to prevent personal data from being accidentally lost, used or accessed in an unauthorised way, altered or disclosed.

**How long we hold your personal data:** We may need to retain some personal data for longer for legal or regulatory purposes. The personal data that is stored on Whole Game System is subject to the FA's privacy policy so we advise you review that policy together with this notice.
