Football Development Officer (Full Time)

Stockton Town Football Club is seeking highly motivated, enthusiastic and reliable coach to fill the role of the Club's Football Development Officer. The role is to support and develop our junior teams, junior players and junior team Managers and Coaches. This position reports directly to the Club Chairman and you will be responsible for the delivery of the Football Clubs Football Development Plan alongside the Club's Executive Committee.

In conjunction with our site partners, Stockton Sixth Form College, the club is seeking to develop a football academy for post 16 students in 2019-20. This initiative will seek to provide a progression route to coaching roles and football related employment opportunities, alongside the training and playing opportunities for students. The role of Football Development Officer will be key in shaping and refining this provision alongside the college leadership. Initially, the role will focus on the planning of the shape of this offer and publicity for the project through the development of excellent links with local schools and student recruitment.

Hold a minimum FA Level 2 Qualification and clean DBS (Working towards Level 2 would be considered) F.A. Youth Module 1 (YAM 1-3 is preferred)

Hold current and valid First Aid & Safeguarding Children certificates.

- Develop, support and encourage Club Coaches in their coaching aspirations.
