



**UEFA EURO 2020 London

Tournament overview

Contested every four years, the **UEFA European Championship** has been showcasing the continent's top talent since its inception in 1960. **UEFA EURO 2020** will celebrate 60 years of the tournament and will be played as a 'Euro for Europe' in the Summer of 2020 across 12 host countries and cities for the first time.

London and Wembley Stadium will host 7 UEFA EURO 2020 matches between June and July 2020 – three group stage matches, one last-16 match, both semi-finals and the showpiece Final.

Volunteer programme overview

In order to deliver the best UEFA EURO Tournament yet, we are recruiting and training approximately **1300 volunteers** to be part of a meaningful, high quality and memorable volunteer programme in and around Wembley Stadium. Volunteers will assist with the delivery of the event through a wide range of important roles from Accreditation, Broadcast, Logistics, Event Transport, Spectator Services and Workforce amongst many others.

With the help of the 1300 volunteers, together, we'll showcase Wembley Stadium, London and its diverse population and unique culture to hundreds of thousands of spectators and an estimated 5 billion TV viewers.

In addition to the 1300 UEFA EURO 2020 volunteers in and around Wembley Stadium, the Mayor of London, on behalf of the host city of London will be recruiting 2000 volunteers who will create a great atmosphere in transport hubs and at fan-zones.

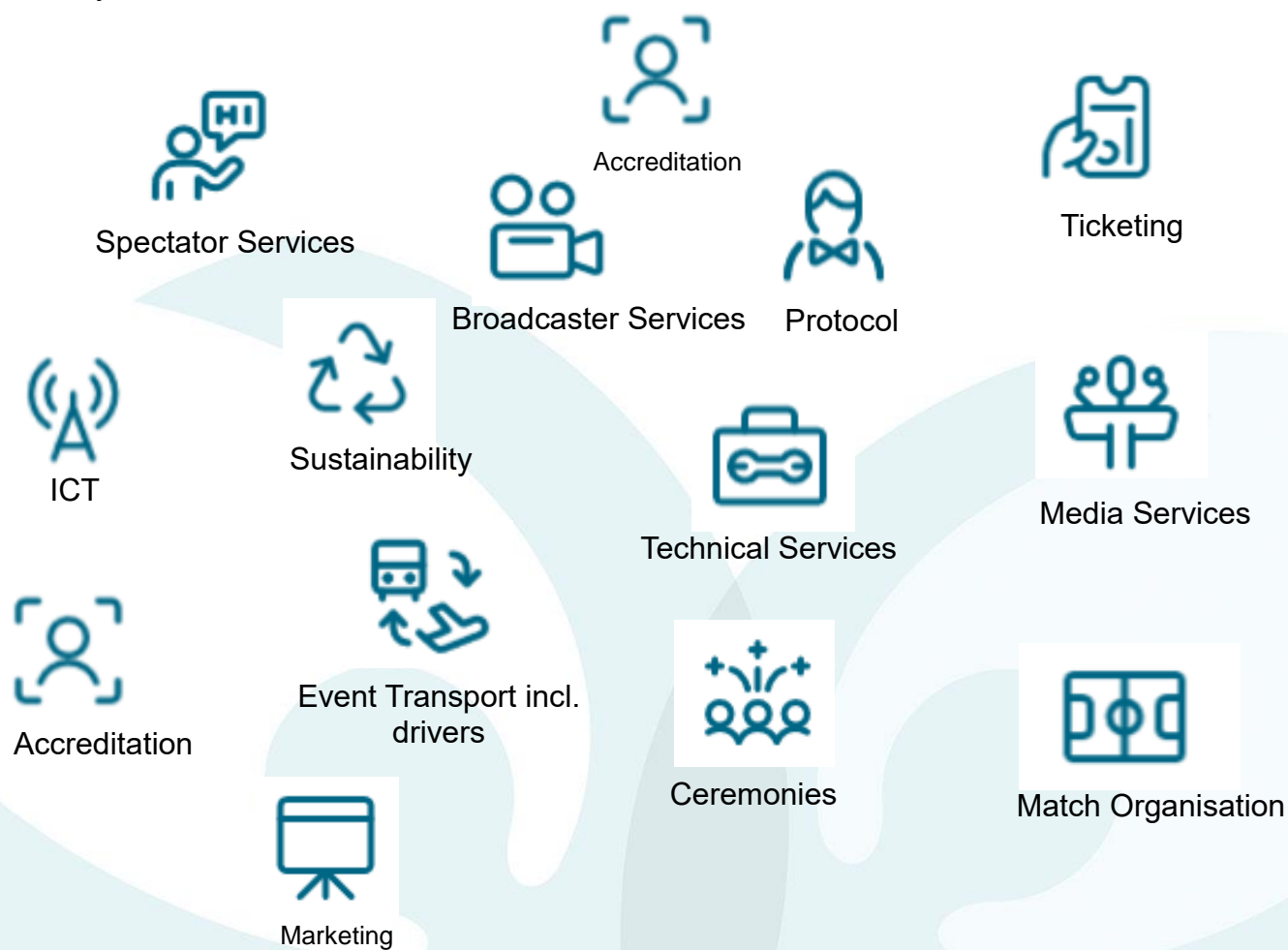

Volunteer roles

There are 1300 Volunteer roles available at UEFA EURO 2020 in and around Wembley Stadium across a range of teams including those shown below.

The majority of Volunteer opportunities will be in Spectator Services and Transport and when you fill in the application form in June you'll be able to select the 3 teams that you believe you're most suited to.



There are also 2000 volunteer opportunities available in the Citywide volunteer programme run by the Mayor of London, across transport hubs and fan zones in London. Applications for this programme also open in June 2019.



Match days at Wembley Stadium – save the dates!

Volunteers will be required to be available for all **7 match days** at Wembley Stadium and some roles will require volunteers to be available for longer i.e. up to 20 days.

The dates of the 7 matches at Wembley Stadium are shown below and we'd ask that you save these dates in your diary now. Nearly all roles will also require volunteers to be available on the day before the first match day (Saturday 13th June 2020).
