



## **STANDALONE EMERGENCY FIRST AID OR SAFEGUARDING COURSE**

Thank you for your interest in hosting a STANDALONE Emergency First Aid or Safeguarding course. At West Riding County FA we pride ourselves on one of the biggest Coach Education programs in the country and it is our aim to have every junior team to have a qualified coach working with their clubs to provide the best learning environment for every player.

### **OPTION ONE**

We already have a wide range of courses available on our website [www.westridingfa.com](http://www.westridingfa.com) so ask your coaches to look at the dates and venues and see whether any future courses are suitable. You then book online! (Cost £35 First Aid, £30 Safeguarding)

### **OPTION TWO**

We can organise a course at a venue near you. We use several venues across the County. You pick a date, we book the venue and the tutor, we send you a link that you distribute to your coaches to book online before we open up to the public to fill the spaces. (Cost £35 First Aid, £30 Safeguarding)

## **OPTION THREE**

Aim to book a course at your club/league specifically for your club/league! To do this we need to do a site visit, this a 20 minute visit to assess your venue and ensure that you have the adequate facilities to run a course. During this visit we will sit down and complete a risk assessment with you. If the venue is suitable we will then ask you to offer some dates that you wish the courses to run and we will source a tutor and confirm the date with you. You will then receive a blank register template that will need returning, complete to myself 48 hours prior to the course.

*If you select option 3 you will be charged for a minimum of 12 \* £30 = £360.00 (safeguarding)*

*12\*£35 = £420.00 (first aid)*

*For every additional learner you will be charged an extra £30. (SG) £35 (F.Aid)*

*If you fill the course (18 for first aid, 24 for safeguarding) you will receive two free places. These two free places are used to cover facility costs for your club.*
