A word from the Secretary:

“Our stand out results during our Cup campaign have to be the 3-3 draw against Cribbs reserves. We scored 2 last minute goals to take it to penalties. We beat our title rivals, Avonmouth 4-2.

Our push for the League Cup fell short at the Semi Final stage to Almondsbury reserves. Awful weather conditions on top of a poor performance saw us lose 1-0.

A slow start to the league campaign in which we drew our 2 games which has ultimately cost us a chance at the title. We recovered well, going unbeaten until middle of March 2022, and amassing the club's highest number of points at this stage in their history.

With two games to go the league title is not impossible but very improbable with other teams needing to drop points.”

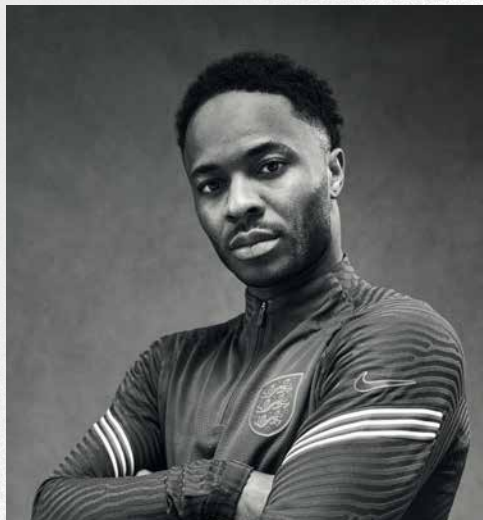
