Route to the Final

The conditions that day were tough on a very poorly maintained pitch. The game ended 2-2 after 90 minutes with goals from Danny Daly and Callum Cannings. 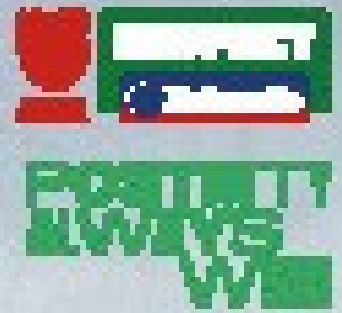
