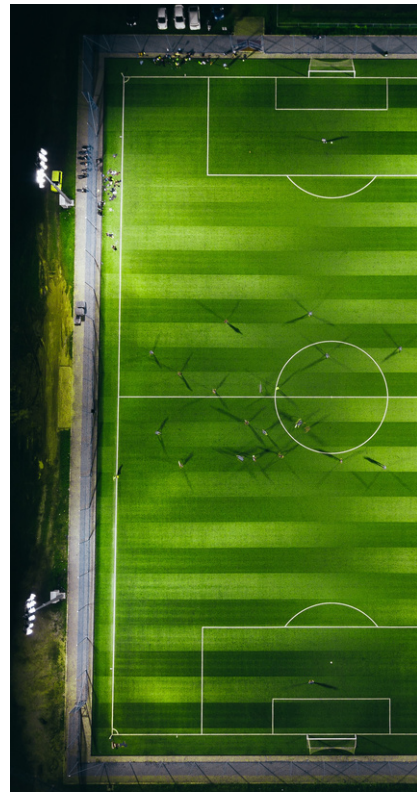

Season so far

Avonmouth are looking to try and accomplish an impressive treble this season. They currently sit top of the Bristol Suburban premier league having not lost a match all season, they also will appear in the leagues Alf Bosley Cup next month.

Avonmouth's run to the GFA Cup final began with a convincing 4-0 win against Oldland Abbotians Reserves from Bristol Premier Combination Division 1. They then faced three Premier Combination Premier teams, Beating Nicholas Wanderers 6-1, DRG Frenchay 5-1 and St Nicholas 7-1. In the Semi-final Avonmouth travelled away to Gloucester County Leagues Broadwell Amateurs, where they took nearly 100 supporters across the Severn to watch an Impressive 2-0 victory.

The Club has been just as impressive off the field as well with their developments as they look to climb the league pyramid. A bar extension and a new changing room block were among the redevelopment, which was then capped off with the addition of floodlights being added last summer.

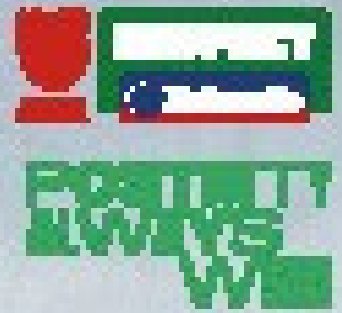
