## Season so far

Following a successful first season in the Evesham & District Sunday Football League last year (2021/22) and gaining promotion to Division 2 after losing only one game, this season got off to a rocky start. With a squad dilapidated by injury and many availability issues, we lost our first three league games but did manage an internal cup win against Division 1 opponents. We achieved our first league win of the season on 9th October, and from November went on a 6-game unbeaten run in all competitions. At the time of writing, we find ourselves in a mid-table league position, 14 points off the top spot with eight games to play and games in hand over all but one of the teams ahead of us in the table.

## Road to Final

Our County Cup journey started with an Away Walkover. We were drawn against AFC Renegades, the same team who knocked us out of the first round of the County Cup last year, but they sadly folded. The Quarter Final saw us travel to Tewkesbury Athletic, and a brilliant goal by Vice Captain Matt Watkins, assisted by Jack Beardsell in the 59th minute, was enough to see us progress to the Semi-Finals.

The Semi-Final draw saw us face Marling Juniors, but a problem with their pitch meant the fixture was reversed, and we gained a home advantage. After going two goals down in the first 10 minutes, Harry Davies opened the scoring for us in the 16th minute, assisted by Jack Spark. This was followed by a goal from Jack Beardsell, assisted by Matt Watkins in the 23rd minute. We conceded again only 3 minutes later, but in the 36th minute, the referee awarded us a penalty, which Harry Davies sent past Marling's keeper in the 36th minute, bringing the game level at halftime. We started the second half against ten men after Marling had a player sent off at halftime. The game looked all set to go to penalties as chances came and went, but in the 90th minute of the game, Jack Spark scored our winning goal, securing our spot in our first-ever Cup Final. We would like to take this opportunity to thank all of our supporters who have come to cheer us on this season, rain or shine. 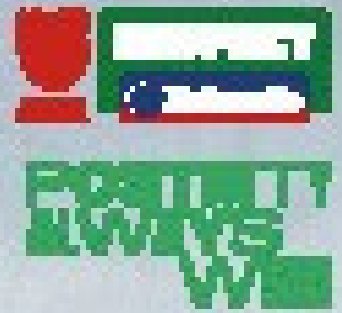
