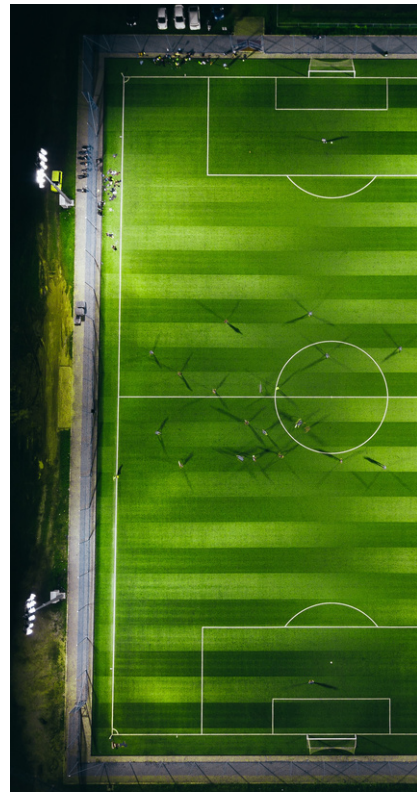

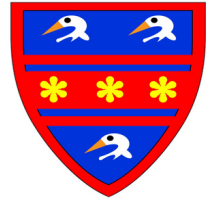

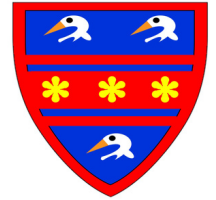

Season so far

Our season in Cheltenham Youth League Division 1 began with a defeat, which was not an ideal start to the season, but it gave us a reality check and made us aware that it was going to be a difficult league to compete in.

We then picked up our levels and started to compete, we have sat around the top third of the table all season, and although we have ultimately come up short for challenging for the league, the progress the team has made has been remarkable.

We entered the County Cup to test ourselves against the best teams in the county. Round 1 we were drawn away to Tewkesbury Town Colts Pumas, it was a closely fought game but we came out as 2-1 winners. Round 2 saw us drawn away again, this time to Fairford where we came out as comfortable 11-2 victors. Round 3 saw us at home to our local rivals, Tuffley Clarets, with another comfortable victory 6-0 which saw us into the quarter finals. Our Quarter Final fixture was a home fixture against another Cheltenham League team, Bourton Rovers Youth, and we were again comfortable 7-0 winners. The Semi Final was an away fixture against a very strong St Aldhelms Juniors team, the game was a real end to end battle with both teams playing great football. It was a game controlled by the players on the pitch, not the coaches, which is again a testament to their footballing acumen. In a hard fought battle, where we played some of the best football of our season, we came out as 3-1 winners to put us through to our first ever County Cup final. Throughout the tournament the boys have surprised us coaches and our parents and supporters.
