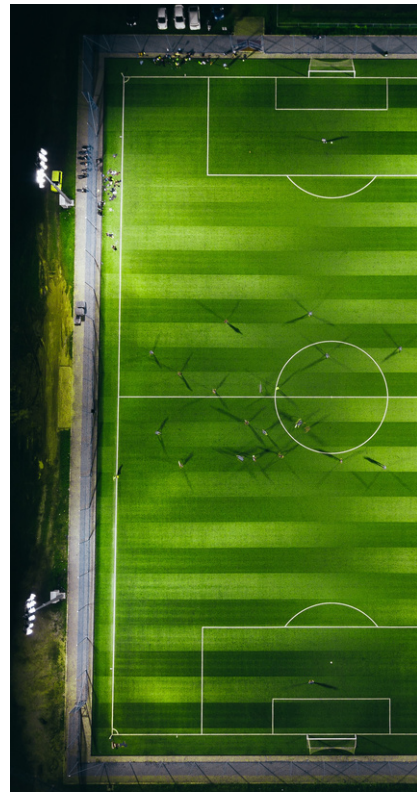

## Season so far

Having been promoted in the 21-22 season, Pucklechurch took to Tier 6 football well, and were crowned Champions of the South West Regional Women's Football League Eastern Division with three games left to play. If Pucklechurch avoid defeat in their final league fixture, the team will have completed back-to-back unbeaten league seasons. The team have also had FA Cup success this year, reaching the first round proper for the first time in their existence.

To reach the Gloucestershire FA Women's Trophy final, Pucklechurch have faced some stern opposition right from the very first round, where they edged past a determined Bristol Rovers Development side. An Adele Hooper double was enough to clinch a 2-1 victory and progress into the next round. Up against SGS Olveston in the second round, Pucklechurch recorded a 5-1 win, away from home, to set up a rematch of last year's Women's Trophy Quarter final with Frampton. Pucklechurch bettered last year's result, coming from behind twice to win 3-2.

The semi final saw us face familiar opposition in St Vallier, having narrowly edged past them on penalties previously this season in the FA Cup. A 2-0 win completed Pucklechurch's route to the County Cup final where they will face tonight's opposition Forest Green Rovers of the South West Regional Women's Football League Premier Division for the second competitive match between the teams.

## Season so far

A strong second season in the South West Regional Women's Football had seen Forest Green Rovers lead the league for much of the campaign - before finishing 3rd in the table, an improvement on the previous season's 5th place finish. With the help of goals from top scorers Nynka Rucker and captain Hattie Jones, the team has maintained good form throughout the season, including in the county cup. A tough draw saw FGR face Bristol Rovers Women in the first round, but goals from Zoe Boyd and Hattie Jones settled a hard-fought tie with a 2-0 win. In the quarter-final vs Tuffley, Forest Green conceded their only goal of the cup run early on in the game, before turning it around with some free-flowing exciting football, including goals from 6 different scorers. This form was continued into the semi-finals, where the team beat Downend Flyers by the same margin at home at Hartpury University to set up the cup final at the GFA.

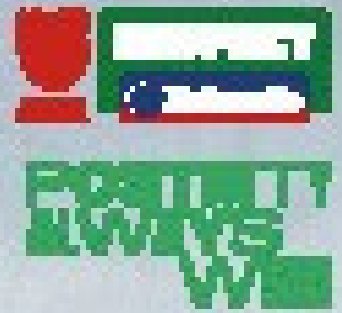
