




Gloucestershire FA County Cups Committee Board

Manager's Comment

Taverners have had a remarkable season in Stroud League 1 after earning promotion last year. The club secured the runners-up position and embarked on an impressive journey in the league cup, reaching the semi-finals.

The club's strategic move to disband the reserve side in 2021, aimed at solidifying its future, resulted in the first team's transition from the Northern Senior League Div 1 to the Stroud Leagues, the first time in over three decades, since the 1991/92 season. Mark Harsant, then the reserve team manager, assumed leadership from Taverners legend Dale Russell upon his return to the club following a brief absence.

During the 2021/22 season, Harsant's squad comprised former reserve players, a few retained first-team members, and promising young talent. Despite the transitional phase, the team managed to secure a commendable 9th place finish. In the following season, more emphasis was placed on integrating youth into the squad, resulting in a successful promotion campaign. The youthful lineup proved their mettle, leading to their retention for the current season.

In our journey through this GFA County Cup Competition, we've experienced thrilling moments. Jer Ward's heroic penalty saves thwarted Wotton Rovers' progress, while a last-gasp header from Charlie Daniels secured our place in the final. The last time Taverners reached a County Cup Final was 22 years ago, in the 2001/02 season, when the club triumphed over Longlevens in front of a crowd of 500 at Forest Green Rovers.
