





- Opens opportunities to access funding (coming up)







## **Funding Opportunities**

- Sport England Community Emergency Fund
- Local Authority Funding
- Football Foundation Funding:

  - Improvements to playing surfaces



## **New FF Pitch Preparation Fund**

- Launched on 7th May closes on 25th May.
- £9.56m pot.
- Clubs & Organisations who have security of tenure over their site & responsibility to maintain their own grass pitches.
- Up to £1,500 per 11v11 pitch
- Maintenance works required at start of season, aeration, seeding etc.

## Safeguarding/DBS Checks

- Engaging with U18's Online Extended Safeguarding Guidance
- DBS Checks/Covid-19 (Issued 2<sup>nd</sup> April)
- FA implementing temporary changes whilst football is suspended as a result of Covid-19
- Government policy of social isolation and football being suspended prevented the verification of DBS checks.
- 1. Not to submit or start new applications whilst football is suspended
  - Individuals whose DBS is due to expire between 1<sup>st</sup> March 2020 and 1<sup>st</sup> October 2020 will not be required until 1 year after expiry date.
