We are looking for students to specialise in **one or more** of the following areas with the option of **flexible working** across the county, including our hub sites. Below you can find a brief description of roles and where they are likely to be based (due to the ongoing impact of Covid-19, these are all flexible). On the following page you will find the core skills, experiences, roles and responsibilities which are required of you regardless of which of the roles you choose.

Dependant on your chosen role you will either be reporting into Football Development Manager, Adult Male Football Development Officer, Women & Girls Football Development Officer, Facility Operations Manager or Front Lawn Community Hub Facilities Manager.

The following statements should give you a flavour of what each role entails and what is expected of you if you once you have chosen a specific area of work:

Male Football Development Intern (Flexible working location)

- Support the delivery of league and club engagement projects (Early Warning System & Play On Website)
- Support the delivery and development of affiliated and recreational male football
- Deliver male football development specific projects (Play On Leagues & Just Play)

Women & Girls Football Development Intern (Flexible working location)

- > Support the growth of affiliated and recreational female football
- > Support the development of a more diverse workforce through female coaches, referees and volunteers
- Deliver female football development specific projects (Euro 2022 Legacy)

Equality, Diversity & Inclusion Intern (Flexible Working Location)

- Support Inclusion Advisory Group
- Support in delivery of Equality Data Audit
- > Deliver equality, diversity and inclusion specific projects

Football Development Intern (Stoneham Lane Football Complex, Southampton)

- Support the site staff in operational tasks such as opening/changeover/closing; managing bookings; working the bar/reception/kitchen and pitch maintenance
- > Develop recreational football development projects for the local community and to maximise usage of site (predominantly during off peak times)
- Deliver development projects on behalf of development team at the site

Sports Development Intern (Front Lawn Recreation Ground, Havant)

- > Support the site staff in operational tasks such as opening/changeover/closing; managing bookings; working the bar/reception/kitchen and pitch maintenance
- Develop recreational sports/football development projects for the local community and to maximise usage of basketball, netball and tennis on site
- > Deliver development projects on behalf of development team at the site
