Futsal Referee Developer specifics:	
Delivery requirements	Must be able to commit to delivering a minimum of 2 FA Futsal Referees Courses per 12 month period (subject to FA/CFA demand). Attend continuous professional development (CPD) as required.
Fees	£150 plus agreed expenses with the delivering CFA. Call back fee additional as agreed with CFA/FRRDO
Course content	Relationship building, dealing with fouls and misconduct, decision making, communication and management, managing restarts and set pieces and basic positioning.
Course duration	One day (8 Hours) call back as agreed with CFA (additional fee TBA).

Mandatory training	Relevant safeguarding qualification, Level 1 Introduction to First Aid in Football (or in date previous FA Emergency Aid) and an in date DBS check.
