CLUB HISTORY

On March 25th, 1992, Aldershot FC became the first Football League team to fold during the season since Accrington Stanley in 1962.

From the ashes came phoenix club Aldershot Town, who were formed on April 22nd, 1992, and managed by ex-Aldershot FC centre back Steve Wignall.

The "new" Shots began life in Isthmian League Division 3 and opened the 1992-93 season in a carnival atmosphere at the Recreation Ground against Clapton. Braces from Mark Butler and Steve Stairs secured a 4-2 win in front of 1493 fans, which was more than watched their predecessors' last home game at the same ground.



CAMBERLEY TOWN (U18) RYMAN

CLUB HISTORY

Founded | 1895 Nickname | 'The Krooners' Home Colours | Red & White Away Colours | Blue & Yellow Ground | Krooner Park Capacity | 1,976 Senior League | Combined Counties Prem South Youth League | Isthmian Youth League West

The club was established in 1895 after a discussion at St Michael's church, and was originally named St Michael's Foot- ball Club, although they became known as St Michael's, Camberley.

The first match, a friendly, was played on 16 October against D Company from the Royal Military College in nearby Sandhurst; St Michael's won 4–2. In January 1896 they joined the Surrey County Football Association, entering and winning the Surrey Junior Cup in 1897–98; the club's first competitive game was played on 16 October 1897, a Junior Cup first round match against Farncombe which St Michael's won 5–2. After winning the cup, the club joined the East & West Surrey League for the 1898–99 season.

In January 1901 a public meeting was held, at which it was decided to establish a new club that would absorb both St Michael's and Camberley Magpies. The name Camberley & Yorktown was adopted and the club took St Michael's place in the East & West Surrey League. However, they dropped into the Aldershot Combination in 1902, before switching to the Ascot & District League in 1903. The club finished as runners-up in their first season and went on to win the league in 1904–05. They were runners-up again in 1905–06, before winning a hat-trick of successive titles in 1907–08, 1908–09 and 1909–10, remaining unbeaten throughout the third of the title-winning seasons. The season also saw them win the Surrey Junior Cup for a second time, beating Sutton United 2-0 in the final. In 1910 Camberley & Yorktown returned to the East & West Surrey League, which had been renamed the West Surrey League. In 1912–13 the club also entered the three-club Aldershot Senior Civilian League, which they won. They went on to win the West Surrey League the following season.

In 1922 Camberley & Yorktown were founder members of the Surrey Senior League. They won three successive titles in 1930 –31, 1931–32 and 1932–33 and were runners-up in 1938–39. After World War II the club was renamed Camberley, and were Surrey Senior League runners-up in 1946–47, before winning the league's Charity Cup in 1951–52 with a 4–3 win over Chertsey Town. The club were league runners-up again in 1961–62, and adopted their current name on 2 June 1967 after merging with former Parthenon League club Camberley Wanderers. In 1973 they joined the Spartan League, but left to join Division Two of the Athenian League in 1975. In 1977 they switched to Division Two of the Isthmian League, and were promoted to Division One after finishing as Division Two runners-up in 1978–79. Two seasons later they were relegated, and after a single season back in Division Two, they re-joined the Athenian League, which now had a single division.

PLAYERS & STAFF

1. ALFIE B (DEF)

Alfie joined us early in September, but in his time with us has amassed 39 appearances this season. Alfie is as brave as a lion, his no-nonsense style of defending has become his trademark, that, and his attacking threat in the opposition box.

10. JOSH S (DEF)

At 15, Josh was locally the best player of his age group and was the star of his Aldershot District side. Unfortunately, Josh has suffered from a nasty leg break and come back after come back was hampered by different setbacks, one of which was a 6 week concussion lay off sustained in the early rounds of this competition. Thankfully, Josh has got back to form and fitness right at the end of the season.

13. MORGAN B (DEF)

Morgan's season has unfortunately been restricted by injury, but statistics do not lie, more often than not when Morgan plays Camberley win. Morgan is a real leader of men and is a tough tackling experienced player. Put it this way, you want Morgan in the trenches with you.

6. FIN C (DEF)

Whilst many of tonight's team are departing at the end of this campaign, Fin is not, he is the future. As an Under 16 Fin has made 34 appearances at U18 level this year, which is a remarkable achievement, his class and quality has shone through and helped him feature in several different positions.

4. CALLUM W (DEF)

What a player, what a person. Callum made his 1st team debut before he made his U18 debut when as a 16-year-old he started in our FA Cup fixture away to Newhaven in the 2021-22 season. Since then, he has gone on to make 53 1st team appearances and has got 70 U18 Caps. Unrivalled experience which will be vital today. At our recent presentation evening Callum was crowned Young Player of the year.

3. BRANDON V (MID)

They don't make them like Brandon anymore. He's full of energy but is simply one of the most creative players we have in the team with 20 assists in 31 appearances. Brandon is the driving force of our midfield, watch out for him today and don be surprised if it is Brandon playing the Key Pass. Brandon has featured for our 1st team in the CCI.

17. SAM S (DEF)

Sam knows how to win. That is the biggest compliment that anyone could pay any footballer. His experience and streetwise nature sit him above the crowd. This has been invaluable in our season run in and I know that if called upon again today he will always deliver.

15. OLLIE W (DEF) - Captain

In his three years at Camberley, Ollie has become the most decorated Camberley Town U18 Player ever and as captain he is bidding for his second consecutive Hampshire Cup Final victory. Ollie is a technically gifted ball playing Centre Back who has amassed 86 appearances for the U18's and has also featured for the 1st team. When he graduates, he will leave big shoes to fill and at our recent presentation evening he was crowned Youth Team Graduate of the year.

7. ISAAC D (MID)

Isaac is another one for the future that has got some great experience this year, making 29 appearances as an U16. Isaac has great quality on the ball and is developing into a fine holding midfielder. One to watch for the future.

12. MACKENZIE C (MID)

As vice-captain of this team,
Mackenzie has shown how important
he is to structure of the team, popping
up with crucial goals in the season run
in, but being one of the defensive stars
as well. He ability to break up play and
start attacks is superb and is a player
for the future. Mackenzie is another
player who has featured for our 1st
team in the CCL.

16. RYAN R (FWD)

Ryan has one hell of an eye for goal. When he joined us at Christmas, he made an instant impact scoring going on a run of games where he scored. One of his most notable performances came in this competition when he scored and assisted in the Quarter Final fixture against Brockenhurst. Watch out for his left foot!

11. LUIS H (FWD)

A man of many talents, last year
Luis started the Hampshire Cup final
at centre back, this year he will be
looking to start as the striker. In 64
games, Luis has scored 53 goals
for the U18's, 41 of which have been
scored this year a large part as to the
reason why at our recent presentation
evening he was crowned the Club Top
Goal scorer. Luis has also featured
23 times for our first team, most
notably scoring a late equaliser away
at Shaftsbury this year in the FA Cup
forcing a replay.

8. JADYN D (MID)

Jadyn has a wand of a left foot.
Another machine-like player who churns out good performance after good performance, adept at playing in any position in midfield Jadyn has shown his true worth in the biggest of occasions, sometimes sacrificing his attacking flare for the benefit of the team.
