## Introduction

We are very pleased to present the Hampshire FA Annual Report for Season 2023/24. This has been a very exciting year for football in Hampshire with the success of Portsmouth FC Men's and Ladies teams gaining promotion, plus the success of Southampton FC in regaining their status as a Premier League club.

Whilst we of course celebrate the success of our professional teams we also celebrate the continuing development of Hampshire FA with the opening of our fourth football hub site at King George V Football Complex in Cosham, Portsmouth. This was a site that has been in development for a number of years, and we thank Portsmouth City Council and The Football Foundation for their support in making it happen. This further develops our portfolio of hub sites under our operation where we are able to work closely with local clubs and leagues to bring benefit to the local communities by offering a facility that is available all year round whilst ensuring a safe and secure environment for players to grow, develop and enjoy playing the game.

Our Post 16 Academy Programme continues to grow, and we were particularly pleased to introduce a new girls academy team at the start of the season who won their respective league in their first season. We now have 49 students in the academy structure and we thank our lead staff for their efforts in developing this important part of our operation.

Our plans are to continue to improve facilities (both grass and 3G), explore possible new sites whilst keeping key governance matters including safeguarding and EDI (Equality, Diversity & Inclusion) at the top of our agenda along with continuing to work with and support local leagues and clubs.

It has been another challenging yet rewarding year for our staff and we thank them all for their sterling efforts, and last but not certainly not least we thank the army of volunteers who support the game week in week out with relentless energy – without you grassroots football is just not possible.

#### **Our Newest Hub Site**

#### WELCOME TO KING GEORGE V FOOTBALL COMPLEX, COSHAM, PORTSMOUTH

After years of planning, Hampshire FA signed a contract in February 2024 to manage the brand-new King George V Football Complex in Cosham, Portsmouth and make it our fourth hub site to sit proudly alongside Winklebury Football Complex, Front Lawn Community Hub and Stoneham Lane Football Complex.

The partnership between the council, Hampshire FA, the Premier League, The FA and The Football Foundation, led to the development of the football complex, which has two 3G football pitches (one full size and one super-size) with a variety of pitch options for all formats of grassroots football and an impressive high specification pavilion building with four changing rooms, two officials' rooms, and meeting rooms. There is also a bar/café, social space and outdoor space to benefit the wider community.

Hampshire FA CEO, Neil Cassar, said: "Hampshire FA is delighted to be appointed as the operator of the fabulous new King George V Football Complex in Cosham and we very much look forward to opening for the local football community in Portsmouth and surrounding areas. There is no doubt that King George V Football Complex will provide state of the art football and ancillary facilities and we welcome the opportunity to use our expertise and experience of operating three other hub sites in the county to promote, develop and progress this exciting new venue. Working with the collective funding partners, we are positive that King George V Football Complex will be a thriving success. We know that facilities like this one in Portsmouth are vital for local communities and will enable more people in and around the area to have great places to play."

KGV Football Complex also received levelling-up funding from the government towards the new facilities as part of the Hilsea Lines project. Additionally, there was also funding from the Youth Investment Fund (YIF) to create a visitor attraction that ensures young people in our local area have access to regular out of school activities, whilst promoting health and wellbeing opportunities for all to enjoy.

Following an open and transparent process, Hampshire FA appointed Fleur De Lys Youth FC,

#### ROY DAWSON HAMPSHIRE FA HONORARY LIFE MEMBER
