



HSFA Representative Coach (Age Groups Varied)

Role Expectation: To attend all HSFA events involving your age group, including trials, matches and any training sessions, plus any other responsibilities in line with your position.

Responsible for:

- Kit and equipment transportation to and from fixtures.
- Deliver a successful and unbiased trial period, resulting in the selection of a HSFA side.
- Planning and delivering appropriate training sessions. Training is conducted at a coach's request.
- Management of representative side on match days.
- Ensuring the Herefordshire Schools FA Representative team adheres to the FA standards for safeguarding children
- Other duties and responsibilities as reasonable to ensure professional delivery of the Herefordshire Schools FA Representative programme.

Key skills and experience required:

- Current School Role or FA Level 1 Qualification.
- Have or working towards FA First Aid Qualification.
- Knowledge and understanding of child protection issues including holding or working towards a current FA Safeguarding Children Workshop certificate.
- An accepted Enhanced FA CRB (Criminal Records Bureau) Disclosure.
- Ability to travel independently.
