In addition, the IOMFA Junior League requires that coaches/assistants who are pitchside during matches have an <u>IOMFA pitchside ID badge</u>.

## REQUIRED FOR ENGLAND ACCREDITATION

In addition to the above, all youth teams must have one coach or manager who has the <u>Introduction to Coaching Football</u> qualification (former Level 1) AND in date <u>Introduction to First Aid in Football</u> qualification.

A qualified coach or manager must be present at training and fixtures. The coach:player ratio must be 1:16 or less.
