Booking Process

By completing and signing the application form you agree to the following:

Cancellation – The Jersey FA reserves the right to cancel any course up to 48 hours before the event. In this event a complete course refund or credit to an alternative course will be offered.

Refunds – The Jersey FA does not offer refunds however exceptional circumstances may be considered by the Jersey FA Lead Community Coach.

Behaviour – All children are to adhere to the behaviour policy. If a child's behaviour is unacceptable parents/guardians will be contacted to collect their child.

First Aid – A child's health and safety is of the highest priority for the Jersey FA, you agree that we can administer first aid if required/when required and you as the parent/guardian will be contacted in first instance.
