1. What do I do if I am new to coaching and need a DBS?

The requirement for all coaches and volunteers working in youth football remains the same and they are still required to keep their DBS in date. The Club Welfare Officer will be able to assist with the process'

2. What do I do if I have a DBS that ran out during lockdown and I need to renew it?

The requirement for all coaches and volunteers working in youth football remains the same and they are still required to keep their DBS in date. The Club Welfare Officer will be able to assist with the process.

Note: FA DBS that expired between 1 March 2020 and 1 October 2020 have been extended by exactly one year from their expiry date

3. What do I do if any youth team officials do not have an in-date DBS?
