



Council Ambassador Role Description

Overall Purpose:

The main purpose of the role is to provide a platform for young people to support youth participation in grassroots football and in decision making through training, volunteering and project opportunities for those aged 11 – 24 years of age from across Kent.

Qualifications/ Skills/Experience

Ambassadors need to be passionate about and committed to the development of football at a local level and have some knowledge and experience in grassroots football. You will need to be able to demonstrate team working, good communication skills and ability to manage and administrate your own affairs.

All new ambassadors must be aged between 11 – 21 years old on the date of being appointed.

Tasks associated with the role will include:

- Act as an ambassador for the Kent FA.
- Actively engage in and promote partnership working and identify opportunities to enhance activities.
- Adhere and promote Kent FA corporate aims and values.
- Adhere to the FA Safeguarding Children and Equality Policies.
- Attend all Kent FA Youth Council Meetings (At least four per year).
- Attend events and meetings associated with the role.
- Encourage a performance culture which focuses on achieving objectives and targets.
- Prepare for and participate in the discussions, deliberations and decisions of the Kent FA Youth Council.
- Promote an organisational culture aimed at achieving set actions.
- Member of the FA Football Futures Programme.
- Uphold high standards of personal integrity and conduct.
- Willingness to participate actively in the work of the Kent FA Youth Council.

Ambassadors of the Kent FA Youth Council are expected to encourage active debate of football issues with a view to allowing everyone to make a contribution. Dominance of discussions by individuals or a group is not encouraged.
