Lancashire Football Association (Lancashire FA) is seeking five tech-savvy, excellent communicators who can support Lancashire FA's affiliated clubs and leagues with their use of FA based technology systems, including, amongst others, Whole Game System, Full Time, the Matchday App and Matchday Payments via PayPal.

- Position: part-time fixed term self-employed contract, providing 50 hours over the life of the contract
- Start Date: as soon as appointed after the 11th May
- Term: 3 month / 50 hours
- Remuneration: £25 per hour inclusive of all out of pocket expenses

This is a self-employed, freelance contract, running for an initial fixed period of 3 months with provision of 50 hours of support provided over the life of the contract. In due course, there may be occasional travel requirements within the Lancashire area, to provide face-to-face support. This will be dependent on government guidance regarding social distancing at the time.

Technology support of our clubs and leagues is important at Lancashire FA, in order to encourage uptake in these systems that will reduce administrative burdens.

The ideal candidate will have a background in remote technology support and be an excellent communicator who is able to provide clear instructions to people who are not necessarily comfortable with technology.
