Meet the Referee Support Team





Supporting referees after a serious incident

If a referee encounters a serious incident, including; assault, abuse or an aggravated case, we want to be sure we have the support processes in place at the time the referee requires it. These are the processes we as a County FA will commit to in these circumstances to ensure referees are supported in these unfortunate cases

Step 1: Referee Reports Incident too....

League Referee Officer encouraged to ensure incident is report to County FA RAS

Step 2: County FA RAS Contacts Referee

- Makes contact within 24 hours
- Will offer support and explain discipline process
- Will then report to County FA Discipline Team as an urgent action

- Referee will be signposted to further support if required (i.e Referee Support Team)
- U18 contacted by County FA DSO as a minimum

Step 3: County FA Contacts Referee

Step 4: County FA Discipline Team Investigate

- Process of investigation commences
- Gather evidence
- Charge made if appropriate
- Process personal hearing if needed

Within 24 hours of incident

Within 48 hours of incident





Supporting referees at personal hearings

The County FA Football Services Team will provide appropriate information to all personnel attending the discipline hearing.

We know the process of going through personal hearings can be a difficult thing to do. As a referee you are welcome to have someone with you at a personal hearing. This can be a friend or relative, but we can also provide someone with refereeing and safeguarding knowledge if that is best for you. 



Where can you go for support?.....

Step 1 - Contact your League Referee Appointment Secretary

• These often provide good support, will be able to help or signpost you for further support

Step 2 - Contact our Referee Support Team

- Your League Referee Appointment Secretary may signpost you to a support mentor
- You can contact a Referee Support Mentor directly
- Our Referee Support Team are volunteers, so although they are highly skilled, they may not be able to respond straight away

Step 3 - Contact County FA Staff


