Commitments Required

- Attend up to 3 Respect Steering Groups per season; (12th September, Dec/Jan tbc, April / May tbc).
- Attend the following free training during 2018/19 season;
 - FA Unite the Game Workshop and/or Managing the Match Day Environment Coach CPD Event
- Ensure you have appropriate and up-to-date FA Safeguarding Training, which is as follows;
 - Referee or Coach Rep FA Safeguarding Children Certificate
 - Club Rep FA Online Safeguarding for Committee Members
 - All Others FA Cascade Safeguarding Training (this will be delivered as part of the first steering group meeting if appropriate)
- Player (Under 18) Reps **must** be accompanied by a responsible adult at all meetings, training and events in which the young person attends.

Role Purpose

- Support the County FA and stakeholders to monitor, review and develop a Respect Action Plan in Leicestershire & Rutland.
- Engage with the football community in which they represent to understand how the playing environment can be improved across mini-soccer and youth football.
- Champion the Respect Programme across the local grassroots football community.
- Subject to availability, support the delivery and promotion of the Leicestershire & Rutland Respect Week of Action events and campaigns.

- Actively involved in local grassroots football in a league, club, coach, referee, playing and/or parent capacity.
- Involved within a FA Charter Standard Club (only applicable if looking to be a club, coach, player or parent representative).

- Preferably undertook a number of key voluntary roles within grassroots football (*not applicable for a player*).
