THE FA LICENSED COACHES' CLUB

The FA Licensed Coaches' Club provides on-going training and development for coaches as the FA seek to establish coaching as a profession.

In order to become an FA licensed coach you need to hold:

- An FA coaching qualification.
- An in date FA safeguarding children qualification.
- An in date FA approved first aid qualification.
- An in date FA Criminal Record Check (if you are coaching players under 18).

FA Level 1 candidates should be able to access their online learning modules at this link: http://learning.thefa.com/index.php. Then, the candidate(s) should follow the steps below:

SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN RECERTIFICATION

The online Safeguarding Children recertification should be accessible to anyone who has taken a 3 hour, face-to-face Safeguarding Children Workshop and whose qualification is over two years old. Anyone can take this course even if their last qualification was the Online Safeguarding Children Recertification, as long as the qualification is over 2 years old.
