Charge - E3 c or E3 l or E3 h- assault or Improper conduct

Club represented – 2 persons

Background:

Charge of E3 Assault on person or Improper conduct or Improper Conduct (inc violent conduct or threatening language, and a head butt from Alec Layart on a Marina Sands player

Club Response:

Initially a mix up, as the 2 persons present thought it was a “personal hearing” and not a verbal plea. After a break the 2 persons came back in and asked for a plea.

They admitted the charge for Layart, however, the lesser charge of E3h was deemed appropriate as the match official had failed to detail the assault charge in any written evidence. Layart was also found guilty of E3 c

Commission Decision:

The commission decided to charge with E3 c and E3 h and subject to a total of 6 matches and a fine of £80 in total
