PLEASE NOTE FOR CLUBS WHO ARE INVOLVED WITH U18'S AND/OR VULNERABLE ADULTS:

A minimum of two individuals can hold the above four club official roles. For best practice, it is important that the Club Secretary and Club Welfare Officer are held by different individuals.

*Ordinarily, Club Chairmen, Treasurers and Secretaries do not require a check, if they are only administrative roles. However, if the people in these roles also help with coaching or at matches, then they will need an Enhanced DBS Check.
