The successful applicant will be expected to coach our Women's 1st team (including individual player development sessions). They will also oversee the overall coaching provision to our University teams (2 Women's teams, assistants and volunteers) as well as directly supporting the recruitment of future Football players to UEL. The role will also support with supporting the Dual Career players who are part of the West Ham Academy and 1st Team as part of the ongoing partnership.

The coaching role will combine team/individual coaching, recruitment activity and student athlete management throughout the week that will involve daytime and evening sessions with some weekend work.
