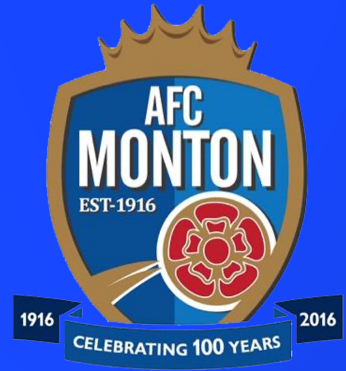
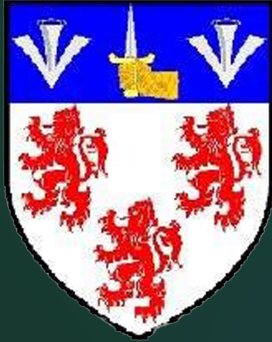

Formed in 1966 by members and staff of West Salford Youth, playing in the Eccles & District Football League. All teams play home games at Salford Sports Village

They have three teams playing in the Lancashire and Cheshire AFL on a Saturday, along with the Vets who play in the top division of the Bolton Sports Federation, over 35's Football League on Sunday mornings.

Today is a long awaited day for the club as it will be the clubs first County Cup final since 2004 when they played in the Saturday Amateur Cup.

# AFC MONTON



Monton Amateurs Association Football Club was formed in 1916, playing games on Monton Green. In 1922 the Club moved to play at Worsley Road and became a founder member of the Eccles & District League before joining the Lancashire & Cheshire Amateur League in 1924 where we remained until 1985 winning the League Championship 8 times and the League Trophy 3 times. In the 1970s we won 18 trophies including the Lancashire Amateur Cup. We entered the Manchester League in 1985 winning the Gilgryst Cup in 1988 and the Open Trophy in 1990 and 1992. The 2013 / 14 season was our most successful in the Manchester League finishing as Premier Division runners up and losing finalists in the Gilgryst Cup. The Club has been extensively developed to a high standard over the years and is now recognised as one of the best in Greater Manchester operating 3 adult teams and 14 junior teams. We are an FA Charter Standard Club and have FA Accredited Standard.
