ANDREW JACKSON, Rochdale Veterans Manager:

Having played for the previous six seasons in the Manchester Vets League, in which all games were played at the same venue on a 3G surface, this season has had a somewhat different feel to it with the team now having home and away fixtures and also playing on grass pitches again, something which a lot of the players hadn't done for a number of years.

The season started with an encouraging 3-1 win at local rivals Wardle, but we were brought down to earth in our first home game, losing 5-3 against Coppice after racing into a three goal lead! Coppice would prove to be our nemesis as we won all of our other league games after that apart from the return fixture with them. After getting into a 3-2 lead in the second half, we let it slip again and ended up losing 4-3 and basically seeing our hopes of winning the league evaporate on a disappointing afternoon in January. The team are determined to finish the season on a high and win the competition for a third time this evening. ??

DOM DOYLE VETERANS

Dom Doyle FC was formed in Denton in 2015 following the tragic murder of Dom Doyle aged 21, on June 7th 2015.

Dom was a talented footballer, so a few of his friends, Jordan McCann, Rick Dorney and Will Hustler came up with the idea to form a football team in his memory.

With enormous support from Billy Hustler, Dom Doyle FC is a family club with great enthusiasm and spirit.

Joining the Tameside League in 2015 with little money and a second hand kit we finished a respectable fourth place in Tameside League Division Two.

In 2016 we became a Chartered Standard Club and Dom Doyle FC we're promoted by the league to the Prem. We also formed a second team (Rangers) who were placed in division 3 of the Tameside League. Both teams finished top and winning of their leagues respectively.

In 2017 we formed our first Youth Team and Dom Doyle FC entered a team into the Saturday Lancashire & Cheshire League division 3, under the Management of another good friend of Dom's, Jack Holland, in which we did the double, in winning the division and Wray Cup, promoted to division 1, in which they are sat at the top

In 2017, following a very successful second season we were nominated for two awards by Manchester FA and won the grassroots 'Best Team of the Year Award' at the Midland Hotel. In 2018 we have also won Pride of Tameside "Club of the Year2, we were then put forward and won North West "Club of the Year" at the Greater Manchester Sports awards held at Old Trafford Cricket Club. The Club also moved to play its home games at Haughton Green Playing Fields where we renovated a derelict Club House.

The teams have won several trophies over the last couple of seasons as we now have 6 teams playing under the Dom Doyle banner

ROCHDALE VETERANS FC

The club was formed in 2015 and entered the Manchester Vets League which was situated at the Failsworth Sports academy. The team enjoyed plenty of success in its early years. Under the managerial guidance of Ross Turner and Paul Adams, the team won the league three seasons running, and also the Manchester Vets County Cup in 2016, beating Oldham Vets in the final, and in 2017 when they beat Chaddy Park Vets 3-1 with the final being staged at Hude United. Neil Wise and Andrew Jackson took over the reigns for the 2018/19 season and the success continued with the league being won again following a nail biting 3-2 win in the last game of the season against their nearest

Both the 2019/20 and 2020/21 seasons were interrupted by the pandemic, during which Neil Wise stepped down leaving Andrew Jackson in sole charge of the team. The Manchester Vets league also folded so the club joined the newly formed Tameside Vets league for the 2021/22 season, playing their home matches at Hopwood Hall College in Middleton. This season saw the team finish league runners up.




