“ Nexgen entered the amateur football world as an under 8s girls team in 2014, prior to the creation of Crompton FC. When the new club formed, the team took the name Crompton Nexgen. I have been in charge since 2014 and has been assisted by Frank Shaw for the last two seasons.

Nexgen have a history of success, including four North Manchester Girls League titles. Consequently, following invitation, the team represented Manchester in the ACES Nationals Competition in Nottingham on two occasions. They were also voted Greater Manchester FA Girls Team of the Season Runners Up in 18/19.

For the 2022/23, Nexgen returned to the North Manchester Girls League, after two seasons in the South. Nexgen won every game of the season, until losing one and drawing two of their final three league games. They ultimately ended the season as Runners Up in 2022/23.

The girls have also fared well in cup competitions this season. Last weekend, they defeated Reddish North End, 5-3, in the semi-finals of the League Cup. They will therefore compete in two finals over the next week, starting with the Greater Manchester County Cup final tonight. ”
