The FA's Whistleblowing Policy

If you have reported a safeguarding concern about a child or an adult at risk and feel that it has not be dealt with correctly. Then there are a number of organisations you can and should escalate your concern to. This is the same if you wish to raise a concern around the behaviour or actions of someone which could lead to potential repercussions against you within your club environment. This whistleblowing policy affords you the chance to get the correct outcome without the risk of it coming back on you from within your club.

Within football:
