It gives me great pleasure in being invited to be Guest of Honour at this the 2021-22 season Senior Challenge Cup Final between Barnet FC and Brentford FC 'B', being played at the Cleo Saul Beveree, home of our host's Hampton and Richmond Borough FC..



This season year see's my 42nd year being completed at Middlesex FA, after returning back 'South' after 3 enjoyable years in the North East, whilst attending Durham University, and re-registering as a Referee with the Association in July 1980.

After being co-opted between 1983 – 89, on the Referee's Committee and Youth Competition Committee, I was co-opted in 1989 and elected to Council in 1990.

Since then, I have served on several standing committees of the Association, including the Youth Division, where I was elected a Vice-President in 2006. I served as a Referee's Appointments Secretary, as well as fulfilling positions on the Adult Cups, Disciplinary and General Purposes Committee's.

In 2018, I was honoured with being elected President of Middlesex FA, after serving as a Vice President of the Association since 2005, where I am currently in my first year of my second term in office.

I was the Associations Honorary Child Protection Officer between 2001-08 and was also a FA Licensed Tutor until standing down in 2016.

After qualifying as a Referee in 1968, following which I was fortunate to be appointed Littlewoods/NABC Junior Cup Final at Wembley and the Varsity Match between Oxford and Cambridge Universities at Fulham FC.

I am currently an FA Contributory League Observer (Level 2b to Level 4), which I am now in my 16th year.

In 2016, I was honoured by the Football Association, becoming a recipient of the FA 50-year Service Medal, following my previous distinguished post holders.

To both the finalists Barnet FC and Brentford FC 'B', congratulations in reaching this year's final, along with our team of Match Officials lead by Conor Griffin who is joined by his Assistants, Nathan Briggs, Sobastian Frazer & Dani Mansour.

ASTON OXBOROUGH

The Norfolk-born goalkeeper signed a season-long loan from Norwich City on the 31st of August.

Oxborough came through the Canaries' academy after being scouted by the Club whilst he was aged 12.

JAKE ASKEW

Jake Askew joined the Club following a spell as Chelsea's Under-18s first choice goalkeeper.

The exciting young prospect has also spent time on loan at Wealdstone, where he won their young player of the season award.

AYMEN AZAZE

The big Belgian goalkeeper is a product of the Barnet FC Academy system and made his debut against Leiston in the FA Cup in October 2020. Following an injury to Scott Loach, Azaze made several First Team appearances during the 2020/21 season before suffering a season ending injury at the back end of the campaign.

JORDAN THOMAS

Jordan Thomas joined the Bees after a successful spell in Norwich City's development teams.

The full-back also tasted First Team experience with the Canaries, making his Premier League debut against Manchester Citu.

TEDDY HOWE

Teddy Howe signed a permanent deal at the Bees on 24th January 2022 after being released by Championship side Blackpool.

The versatile full-back has Football League experience under his belt, having worn the colours of Reading, Blackpool and Scunthorpe United at senior level.

JAMIF TURI FY

Jamie Turley joined the Bees in July 2021 after a threeyear spell at Leyton Orient.

During his time at the O's, Turley achieved promotion to Sky Bet League Two after the East London Club won The National League.

BEN RICHARDS-EVERTON

Richards-Everton moved to The Hive London with a vast amount of experience in the EFL, where he made close to 100 appearances between spells with Bradford City and Accrington Stanley. The big centre-half scored his first Barnet goal in the Bees victory over Weymouth and has been a first team regular since arriving in North London.

ROB HALL

The 28-year-old brings a wealth of Football League experience, having played in all of England's top four divisions.

Hall came through West Ham United's academy before making his first senior appearance for the Irons in the Emirates FA Cup against Sheffield Wednesday in 2012.

ROSS MARSHALL

Ross Marshall signed for Barnet FC from Stevenage on loan until the end of the season in February 2022.

The 6ft 3ins defender came through Ipswich Town's youth system and enjoyed loan spells at Lowestoft Town and Braintree Town before leaving Portman Road in 2019.

LOUIS WALSH

The Bees signed Louis Walsh on a permanent deal from Southend United on 16th February 2022.

Walsh has proven to be a threat through his speed and skill on the wing whilst providing team-mates with assists.

DANIEL POWELL

Daniel Powell joined the Bees on a two-year deal in August 2021, after spending the previous two seasons at Crewe Alexandra, where he scored 12 goals in 60 appearances.

A successful period at Stadium MK followed for Powell as he went on to make 271 appearances, scoring 46 times and assisting 21.

EPHRON MASON-CLARK

Ephron Mason-Clark signed his first professional deal with Barnet in July 2016 after graduating from the youth academy. Possessing the skill to play either as a striker or on the left-wing, he made his debut for the club as a substitute in the Checkatrade Trophy against Norwich Under 23's.

He has established himself as a first-team regular and is a fan favourite at The Hive London.

ADAM MARRIOTT

Joined the Bees following a successful spell at King's Lynn Town where he scored 66 goals in 99 games.

The striker finished as the National League North's Top Scorer in 2019/20, scoring 28 goals in 31 matches as the Linnets achieved promotion.

REISS GREENIDGE

Reiss Greenidge joined on loan from Bolton Wanderers in the summer of 2021. Greenidge has also tasted first-team football in Norway playing top-flight football for Sogndal, whilst also representing Guyana on the international stage.

WESLEY FONGUCK

Midfielder Wesley Fonguck was a youth talent picked up by Barnet from local side Croydon and went on to graduate from the youth academy, making his first-team debut as a substitute in May 2016 against Crawley Town.

Fonguck has been all but ever-present in the Bees squad since his debut and can be a crucial player in the creative role.

HARRY TAYLOR

Harry Taylor's career started as part of the Chelsea youth system in 2005, where he left in 2012 to join Barnet along with his brother Jack. After graduating from Barnet's academy in 2014, the defender has since gone on to make 75 appearances in all competitions.

SERHAT TASDEMIR

Signing for AFC Fylde at the age of 15, following his release from Blackburn Rovers. He made his first-team debut at just 16 in the Lancashire FA Challenge Trophy vs A.F.C. Darwen, scoring a first-half hat trick. Following this, Serhat made his National League debut against Bromley, in September 2017, aged 17, scoring just 14 minutes after coming off the bench.

SAM BEARD

Joined on loan from Dorking Wanderers in April 2021.

Beard played an instrumental part in the Wanderers run to the play-off semi-final in the 2019-20 season, before being a regular as they went top of the National League South before its curtailment.

SAM WOODS

Having come through Crystal Palace's youth system, Woods was sent out on loan to Hamilton Academical in 2020, where he made three appearances and scored on his debut against Livingston.

The 23-year-old defensive midfielder also brings EFL experience into the ranks following a short loan spell at Plymouth Argyle last season, which saw him play nine times for the League One side.

RYAN DE HAVILLAND

Arrived at The Hive London on 26th October 2021 on a long-term permanent deal.

The central midfielder enjoyed a successful youth career at Fulham FC, where he spent 11 years but was released at the end of last season.

Whilst within the Cottagers youth system, the 20-yearold spent a brief loan spell with Metropolitan Police where he featured on three occasions.

REECE GREGO-COX

Joined the Bees on a loan deal from Crawley Town until the end of the 2021/22 season.

The 25-year-old came through Queens Park Rangers' academy and made his Premier League debut for the Hoops against Tottenham Hotspur in 2015.

Grego-Cox made a further five first-team appearances and also enjoyed a loan spell at Newport County before leaving The Kiyan Prince Foundation Stadium in 2018.





Age 18

An England youth international, Matthew Cox joined Brentford B from League One side AFC Wimbledon in the summer of 2021. The talented goalkeeper progressed rapidlu during his time with The Dons and he has been involved with the Young Lions in recent weeks for England Under-19s.

BEN WINTERBOTTOM

Age: 20

Ben Winterbottom has made the most appearances in goal for the B Team this season with 18 at the time of writing. The keeper joined The Bees from Liverpool in January 2021 having been a part of the Under-23 set up at Anfield. Prior to joining The Reds, Ben spent a lot of his youth career with Blackburn Rovers as he rose through the ranks before heading to Merseyside.

ROCO REES

Age: 20

Roco Rees joined the B team in September 2021 after departing Brighton & Hove Albion having been there since the age of 12. The youngster signed his first professional contract with The Seagulls in July 2020 and also agined experience out on loan with Worthing FC.

BEN HOCKENHULL

Age: 20

A former Manchester United youth player, Ben Hockenhull is in his second season with The Bees. The imposing central defender has the ability to win the ball in the air. but is also a talented defender with the ball at his feet. Having come through the ranks at Old Trafford, he swapped the North West of England for West London in July 2020 and has been a key member of the squad.

TRISTAN CRAMA

Age: 20

French defender Tristan Crama is in his second campaign with Brentford B having arrived from Béziers ahead of the 2020/21 season. He has been a consistent figure for the team this season and is pushing towards the 30-appearance mark. He has also been on the scoresheet four times.

NICO JONES

Age: 20

Age: 19

A summer arrival following his departure from Oxford United. Nico Jones has had a promising start to life in West London. He has been a regular for the side this season in defence having featured in matches across Europe and in England, November 2019 saw the defender make Oxford United history as he became the club's uoungest ever captain at the age of just 17.

DANIEL OYEGOKE

Defender Daniel Ouegoke linked up with Brentford B in the summer of 2021 after departing Arsenal. The talented full back began his career with Barnet before joining The Gunners at the age of 14. He worked his way through the youth system and turned out for the Under-23 side at the Emirates stadium and also regularly represents England at youth level.

JUDE RUSSELL

Age: 20

Jude Russell joined Brentford B in the summer of 2021 bringing his 11-year stay at Crystal Palace to an end. He was part of the Palace Under-23 side that clinched promotion to the Premier League 2 Division 1 during the 2020/21 campaign. Having linked up with Brentford, the youngster has been deployed in central defence as well as wing back over the course of the season.

LEWIS GORDON

Age: 21

Lewis Gordon joined Brentford B in the summer of 2020 having departed Watford's youth setup. Lewis came through the ranks at Watford, representing the Under-18 side before progressing onto the Under-23 team at Vicarage Road. The defender made his First Team debut for The Bees in January 2021 against Middlesbrough in the Emirates FA Cup.

He also had a loan stint with Hampton & Richmond Borough. He linked up with Neil MacFarlane's side last season for a trial before putting pen to paper for this campaign. Roy has recently been involved with Albania Under-21s.

Age: 21

Jaakko Oksanen joined Brentford in January 2018 from HJK Helsinki. He made his First Team debut in May 2019 in the Sky Bet Championship against Preston North End and he spent the 2020/21 campaian with AFC Wimbledon. The midfielder spent the first half of this season on loan with Greenock Morton in the Scottish Championship.

Age: 20

Paris Maghoma signed for Brentford B in January 2020 from Tottenham Hotspur. The 18-year-old central midfielder came through the ranks with Spurs and has featured for England at youth level. He scored his first goal for the club in January 2020 when he netted a stunner against FC Astana.

Alex joined Brentford B in September 2020 after departing West Bromwich Albion. He rose through the youth ranks with The Baggies to break into the Under-18 setup. Alex netted two goals in the final ever fixture at Griffin Park whilst on trial, the second a stunning effort from outside the box in what was a 6-3 win over Frith Town. Alex spent the first half of this season on loan with Swindon Town in League Two.

DOM JEFFERIES

Dom joined Brentford B after a trial period in the 2020/21 season. He spent his youth career with Sky Bet League Two side Newport County and worked his way up to become a second-year academy scholar at Rodney Parade. He played six times for Newport's First Team during the 2019/20 season. He has regularly captained Brentford B this season, showing his leadership skills from the middle of midfield.

RYAN TRFVITT

Age: 19

Ruan Trevitt signed for Brentford B in January 2021 as a 17-year-old. He came through the ranks with Leatherhead before joining The Bees following a trial period. The versatile midfielder provides energy and skill in midfield and he has scored six times so far this season. He netted a fantastic individual effort on tour in Curus against FC Rodina Moscow in November last year.
