

Red & Yellow Cards

Red & Yellow cards are on field disciplinary offences which you may see during the season. Red cards are referred to as Standard Charges and Yellow cards are known as Cautions. Below is a breakdown of the offences, along with a guide to how to respond to them.

Cautions

Code	Definition
C1	Unsporting Behaviour (refer to table ->)
C2	Shows dissent by word or action
C2 SB	Shows dissent by word or action (Sin Bin)
C3	Persistently infringing laws of the game
C4	Delays restart of play
C5	Fail to respect required distance at restart
C6	Enter / re-enter field of play without permission
C7	Leave field of play without permission

AA	Adopting aggressive attitude
DI	Simulation
DP	Dangerous play
FT	Foul Tackle
GC	Goal Celebration
HB	Handball
RP	Reckless play
SP	Pulling / pushing
TR	Tripping
UB	Unspecified behaviour

Standard Charges

Code	Definition
S1	Serious foul play
S2	Violent conduct (refer to table opposite ->)
S3	Spitting
S4	DOGSO (handball)
S5	DOGSO (free kick / penalty)
S6	Offensive / insulting / abusive language
S7	Receives a second caution

S2 Offences
Head to head contact
Elbowing
Kicking
Stamping
Striking
Biting
Other unspecified behaviour

Responding to cases

All cases must be responded to using the Whole Game System. You will notice 2 due dates on a case:

- Response date – date by which you must acknowledge a case
- Payment date – date by which you must pay the invoice

You will be charged a late fee of 25% of the invoice total should you miss either of these deadlines.

- Cautions – 14 days to acknowledge
- Standard charges – 7 days to acknowledge
- Invoices – generated every Wednesday, 14 days to pay (unless otherwise scheduled)
