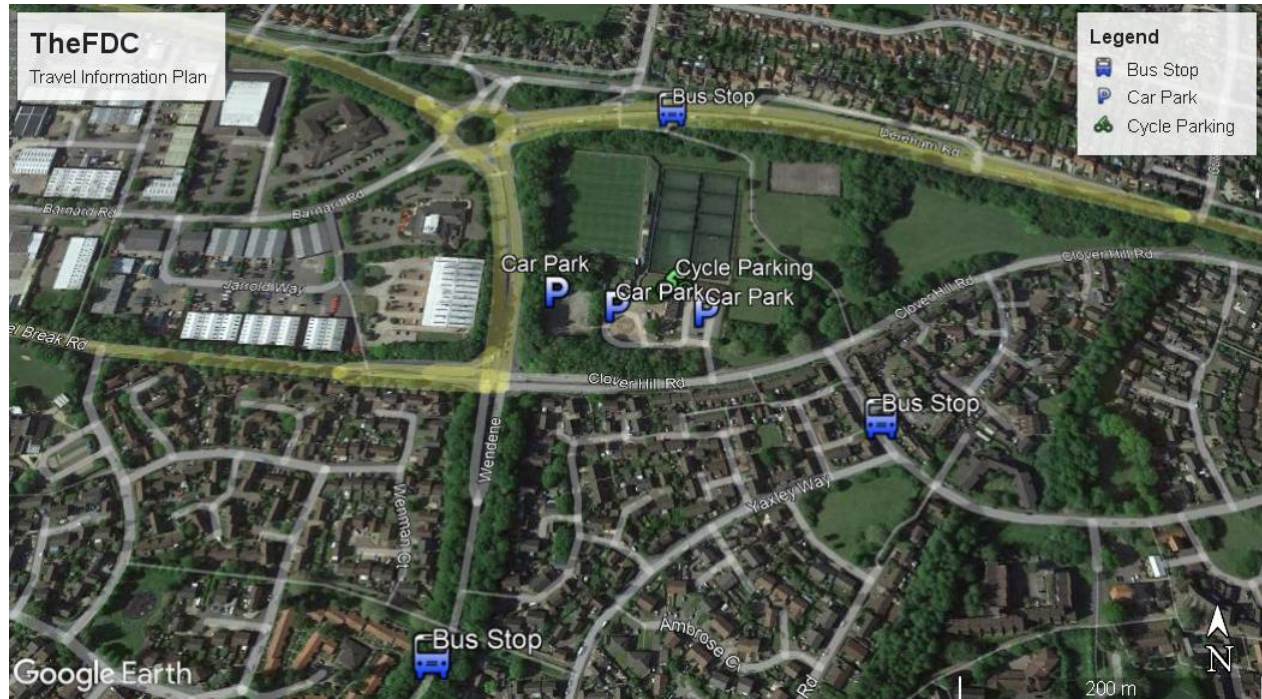

Your local travel options

On foot

- *The FDC is located 0.25 miles from the Dereham Road roundabout, of which a number of amenities are located including the Castle Carvery, Best Western Brook hotel, and Namco Funscape. To walk to the facility via the Dereham Road roundabout walk 0.15 miles along Wendene until you reach the crossroads with Clover Hill Road. Turn left onto Clover Hill Road, and the FDC is located 0.1 miles on the left hand side of the road.*

By bike

- *Covered cycle parking is available onsite.*

By bus

- *The nearest bus stop to the FDC is located on Rawley Road / Yaxley Way, which is 0.1 miles from the facility. The second nearest bus stop is Wendene, which is 0.2 miles from the facility. The third nearest bus stop is located on Dereham Road, which is 0.35 miles from the facility.*
- *The number 21 bus stops at Rawley Road / Yaxley Way. The number 23 or 24 buses stop at both Dereham Road and on Wendene.*

All buses run frequently during the week, evenings and at the weekend.

By train

- *To access theFDC by train you need to get the number 25 bus from Norwich Train Station, getting off at Castle Meadow, then you need to get the number 21 bus from Castle Meadow to Rawley Road / Yaxley Way.*

By car

- *TheFDC is accessible via car, with ample free car parking spaces onsite. The post for the facility is NR5 9ED. TheFDC is located 2 miles from the A47 which is the main a road which circles Norwich from the West, South and East.*
