CHAIRMAN'S INTRODUCTION

As Chairman of the Norfolk County Football Association, it gives me great pleasure to welcome you all to Harrod Sport Arena for our 2025 Norfolk Hire Senior Cup Semi Finals. This evening is the second of our two Norfolk Hire Senior Cup Semi Finals.

The first of the two sides competing for a place in the final is this evening's home side, Wroxham FC. They currently compete in the Isthmian League, North Division. Their opponents are Mulbarton Wanderers FC, who compete one step below them in the Non-League System, in the Thurlow Nunn League, Premier Division.

Wroxham FC currently sit 19th out of twenty-two in the Isthmian League. They have won five, drawn nine and lost thirteen this season, leaving them on 24 points. Wroxham FC entered the Norfolk Hire Senior Cup at the third-round stage, where they beat Watton United, 4-1. They then faced Kings Lynn U23s in the quarter-final, progressing with a comprehensive 5-0 victory.

This evening's away side are Mulbarton Wanderers FC who currently sit 8th out of twenty in the Thurlow Nunn, Premier Division. They have won fourteen, drawn three and lost eight this season, leaving them on forty-five points. Mulbarton Wanderers FC entered the competition in the second-round stage, kicking off their cup campaign with a 2-0 away win at

Norwich CEYMS FC. The third round saw a repeat of the 2020-21 final, with Mulbarton taking on Gorleston FC. However, this time Mulbarton were victorious, beating Gorleston on penalties, seeing them into the Quarter Finals of the competition. Mulbarton continued their good form in the cup with a 5-0 home win against Norwich United, which sees them earn their spot in tonight's semi-final.

The third team on show for tonight's spectacle will of course be the match officials. They, like the teams, have also earned the right to be here, and I would like to extend my congratulations to them on their selection. I wish them every success in what I hope will be a memorable occasion for all involved.

Finally, a thank you to all our Board members who are present, together with the Norfolk FA staff for their hard work coming together to stage the Norfolk Hire Senior Cup Semi Final this evening.

THE NORFOLK HIRE SENIOR CUP

The Norfolk Senior Cup is the County's oldest Cup competition with a history that stretches all the way back to the 1881/82 season when Norfolk and Norwich became the inaugural winners as they beat Lynn Town by 3 goals to 1.

Despite that initial defeat Lynn Town became regular winners of the trophy in the early years, picking up the Cup on no fewer than five occasions: 1882/83, 1884/85, 1886/87, 1889/90, 1898/99. Another name to feature regularly on the Cup in those initial seasons was CEYMS, especially around the turn of the century when they captured a hat-trick of titles. King's Lynn went one better than that as they took the Cup back to the West of the County an amazing four seasons on the trot between 1954/55 and 1957/58, beating Gorleston, Gothic, Great Yarmouth and most impressively Norwich City in that time.

Norwich City did bounce back from that defeat, and in some style too as they took part in one of the competition's highest scoring Finals the following season, beating Gorleston 7-2. Nine goals were also scored in the 1972/73 Final, but this was much closer as Fakenham Town edged past Hoveton by a score of 5-4.


In recent seasons the competition has been dominated by Clubs that compete in the Eastern Counties League. Wroxham were the team to beat in the late 1990's and their name was engraved on the trophy in 1996/97, 1997/98 and 1999/00. Other recent winners include Diss Town, Gorleston, King's Lynn Reserves and Dereham Town.

The 2009-10 Final broke the trend of Eastern Counties winners though, as Mattishall of the Anglian Combination held Norwich United 1-1 at the end of extra time and then held their nerve on spot kicks to win 5-4, claiming a famous victory. Gorleston won the 2011/12 Final 2-0 against Thetford Town and then won the 2014 Final 1-0 against Wroxham.

Wroxham returned to Carrow Road in 2015 to beat fellow Ryman League side Dereham Town 3-2 after extra time. In 2016 Dereham Town secured their fourth Norfolk Senior Cup after beating Norwich United 2-0.

2017 saw King's Lynn Town beat Fakenham Town for their first Senior Cup triumph since 2009. Ryan Fryatt and a Michael Clunan penalty sealed the win.



Mulbarton would then bounce back from this defeat a year later, to face Dereham Town, competing at Step 4 at the time, and would claim a 2-1 victory against the odds. Dereham Town would then attempt the same feat as they made it to back-to-back Senior Cup Final's, however they would fall victim to Gorleston, who claimed their 2nd title in three years, with a 3-0 win at Carrow Road.

Last season's final saw an entertaining evening at Carrow Road as Downham Town caused an upset as they ran out 4-2 winners in The Norfolk Hire Senior Cup semi-final to secure the Senior Cup Trophy for the first time since 1966.
